DCP REDFORD 24-25 DRESS CODE



Students will be required to wear a school uniform on Monday-Thursday and "Free Dress/Dress Down" on Fridays within the outlined parameters.

Students are expected to follow the above dress code every day. Violation of the school's dress code policy is a violation of the DCP-R Code of Student Conduct.

Repeat and/or continued violation of the policy may result in progressive discipline.

SHIRTS

- Plain, solid colored long or short sleeve polo in ANY ONE COLOR
- No stripes or designs

PANTS

- Plain, solid colored shorts, pants, skirts, skorts, or dresses
- No holes, embellishments, cuts, or frays
- Length should be mid-thigh or LONGER than when arm extended down the middle fingers hits the thigh
- NO LEGGINGS
- Belts must be worn for any pants, shorts, and skirts not fitted at waist. Undergarments should never be visible.

SHOES

- Must wear closed-toe shoes
- No Crocs, slides, or bubble sandals allowed

FRIDAY FREE DRESS/DRESS DOWN DAYS

- If a scholar is not dressed appropriately, a parents/guardian will be required to bring a change of clothes to school and scholar may lose privilege to participate in future dress-down days.
- Shorts must be knee length
- No oversized chains of any type
- Jeans/Pants must be worn above the hips no sagging
- No tight-fitting or revealing clothes (e.g., no bodycon or t-shirt dresses)
- No tank-tops, spaghetti strap tops, halter tops
- No hats, hoods, or rags can be worn on the head unless due to religious beliefs
- No strapless tops or dresses, or anything considered revealing; sheer or low cut blouses
- No bare midriffs (e.g., no crop tops, bralettes, sheer/lace tops)
- No exposed underwear (e.g., undergarments, brassieres)
- Skirts and dresses must be at or just above the knee; no skirts and dresses whose hem stops at the hips
- No skirts or dresses with slits past mid-thigh
- No ripped or torn jeans

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
