



Student Dress Code

For Elementary and Middle Schools (K - 7th Grade)

Bottoms: Navy or Khaki

- Walking Shorts, Slacks/Pants, Skorts, or Skirts

Tops: Blue or Gold Polo (available through our school's office)

- Must have school logo on polo.
- Scholars may wear long sleeves underneath, **ONLY** in solid: white black, or navy.

Friday Spirit Wear: T-Shirt & Jogging Pants Set (available through our school's office)

- School t-shirt and jogging pants set with gym shoes are permitted on **Fridays** ONLY.
- School t-shirt and jeans with gym shoes are permitted on **Fridays** ONLY.
- If **NOT** in either option, students **MUST** be in complete uniform.

Shoes: Dark Colored

- Black, brown, blue, and grey are all appropriate dark colored shoes.
- No Gym Shoes **except for when Friday Spirit Wear attire is permitted**

The Dress Code does not allow for clothing with colored trim, stripes, embroidery, decoration, etc. It also does not provide for overalls (overalls with pants or shorts), printed leggings, etc.

The HIAT logo is acceptable.

Other dress code rules:

- A belt is required if the garment has belt loops.
- Shirts (including t-shirts) must be tucked in.
- Shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer- no more than 2" above knee or fingertip length.
- Shoes must be safe and appropriate.
- Clothes must be appropriate size, with the waist line of bottoms worn at student's waist.
- Clothing that is too tight or too loose is not appropriate for school.

School administrators will determine if clothing is appropriate for school and complies with leadership expectations. For more specific information on the student dress code, please refer to the Code of Student Conduct.
